
It is easy to lose sight of the "big picture" which is protecting the freedom of our 2nd Amendment rights.

DISPLAYING YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD

Displaying your Membership ID card while on York Rifle Range Association property.

Although at this time we are not requiring members to display their membership cards while at the range, we want you to start getting use to it. You should ALWAYS have your card with you while you are on the Rifle Range Property. To help you to be able to start displaying

your Membership Card there will be at least 2 styles of card holders available for purchase at the club. You can purchase these the same as targets, soda and ice cream at the club, **On the Honor System.** A clip on style that will be \$1.00 each and a lanyard style that will be \$2.00 each. Although you do not have to purchase one of these from the club, if you would rather purchase one on your own.

It should be mainly clear plastic so that your Membership card is visible through it without having to take it out. Your card should be 100% visible when it is inside the holder. Hunting License holders or similar type of holder will also be acceptable to display your York Rifle Range Membership card.

ber ship will end and you will be required to re-apply for membership to be able to use any of the facilities.

Senior 18yr - 65yr \$20

Junior up to 17yrs \$5

Life Membership status is achieved at age 65 or better with 15 yrs consecutive membership and takes affect the following year.

New Member Application fee - \$20

For those of you that have recently sent in your dues, I will be sending out your new 2010 membership card shortly. If you have paid your dues and it has been over 2 weeks and you have not received your membership card, email me at YRMembership@comcast.net include your current mailing address.

Please retain your current GREEN key card that was issued for 2009....this GREEN card will also be used for 2010. You will receive a new membership card, which you must have with you while on York Rifle Range property to properly identify your membership.

You will notice this year that the Membership card is a little different from years past. IN the Lower Left corner, or the lower right corner if you are looking at it from the back, you will see you Member #. This # is now assigned to you and will be the same year after year as long as you pay your dues on time. Please refer to this number when paying your dues next year as it will help speed up the process and assure the correct membership is being renewed. Also, Make sure to update the Club Mailing address if you pay you dues on-line from your bank account.

Membership Status - adding new members soon!

The club will be opening up it's Senior membership in February 2010.

It has been over a year since we added New Senior level Members to our club due to the membership level being restricted to 1,000 Senior Members.

We will be increasing our Senior membership level from 1,000 to 1,200 members at the February Club meeting. If you have sponsored someone currently waiting to become a member you can let them know that it will not be much longer.

If you would, please make sure that they are still interested in becoming a member and let me know if they are not.

Firearm Safety

When using or storing a gun, always follow these NRA Safety rules:

Know your target and what is beyond.

Know how to use the gun safely.

Be sure the gun is safe to operate.

Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.

Wear Eye and ear protect as appropriate.

Never use alcohol or over the counter, prescriptions or other drugs before or while shooting.

Store guns so they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.

Be aware that certain types of guns and many shooting activities require additional safety precautions.

REMEMBER!!!!
