NEW Access gate to be installed

Special ATTENTION

We have contracted Security Fence Company to install the New automatic access gate. The installation schedule is still being worked on but we did not have exact dates before we sent this Newsletter to the printer. Once it is complete we are going to connect it to the same system that operates the Clubhouse door. Your white access card, or the key fob that you were issued, will unlock both the automatic gate and the clubhouse door.

The NEW gate will be installed at a new location from where it was in the past. For now the current gate will stay installed where it is, just off the main road. The NEW GATE will be installed

across the road just before the Storage garage on the left side of the road. Although it will be very close to the clubhouse, there will be extra fencing installed into the woods that will stop non-membership from being able to drive into the range area. You, as a member, should not park on the outside of the gate and walk around the fencing to gain access to the club. Use your card to open the gate, wait for the gate to open all the way and then proceed through to a parking area. If you don't have "time" to wait for the gate to fully open you should come back another day when you have time to wait the extra 10 seconds that it takes for the gate to open.

The club is not responsible for any damage caused to your vehicle because you didn't have time to wait for the gate to fully open or you tried to squeeze in before it closed from a person in front of you.

You must have your current year's Membership card and access card with you at ALL TIMES while you are on Range Property. If you forget your card you will not be able to open the gate to get in.

One other note that we will send out more information about later. We will be installing Security cameras at the gate and at points around the club as we have one or more people coming to the club

that wants to continue to damage the property while they are here. Although the cameras will not actually stop the damage, we will know who to contact.

REMINDER TO EVERYONE. The White access card or Black Key fob that you now have DOES NOT get replaced each year. **It is assigned to you for as long as you are an active member of the club.** If you lose it or it gets damaged, you can get a replacement card or Key fob at the cost of \$10. Replacements can be picked up and paid for before or after, the Monthly Club Meetings held the 2nd Tuesday each month. I no longer mail replacements.

At the end of the Honorary 1 year membership, the honorary members may continue their membership as a Senior member by sending the yearly membership fee of \$20. The normal application fee of \$20 for new members will be waived if they continue their membership immediately upon the completion of the Honorary membership term.



High Power News

The York Riflemen have six NRA-Approved High Power Rifle Matches scheduled for the upcoming 2012 season. (80-round matches) and one CMP John C. Garand match. Last season's match results can be viewed at on the club web-site at <http://www.yorkriflemen.org/HighPowerTeam.htm>. The regular 2012 season matches will be held on the 4th Sunday of the month, April through September. We intend to inaugurate the 2012 season with a combo-match day scheduled for April 22,

2012. A CMP sanctioned John C. Garand Match in the morning followed by a 50-round NRA approved High Power Match immediately after the Garand Match. The remaining High Power match dates are May 27, June 24, July 22, and September 23. The Club Memorial Trophy Match will be August 26, 2012. Junior competitors are welcome, and anyone interested in the formation of a two to four-person junior team for Camp Perry is welcome to contact Fred Haag or Adam Jones. Details of the upcoming

More..... Frequently Asked Questions

Q. I did not receive my Membership renewal form in the mail, when do they get mailed?

A. We DO NOT mail individual renewal notices. Membership Dues are due every year by December 31st for the following year. There is a 1 month grace period. Put a reminder on

your calendar so you don't forget.

Q: What are the hours members can use the club?

A: Your access card is set to unlock the clubhouse door, (and gate), between 6:00am and 11:00pm. You can use the indoor .22 rifle range during these times. Out door shooting is allowed between

8:00am and sundown. Because we have neighbors, no outside shooting is allowed outside of these times.

Q: What are the age ranges for the Memberships we have?

A: **Junior Members** are from born, up to 18 years old. A Junior becomes a Senior Member the next

membership year after they turn 18.

Senior Members are age 18 and up.

Life Membership takes effect the next membership year after you turn 65, as long as you have 15 consecutive years membership just prior to turning 65. Or any age over 65 after 15 consecutive years.
