## **Updated Requirements for NEW MEMBERS**

#### SPECIAL NOTICE!!!!!!

At the time this Newsletter was published there are 2 Amendments to the Club's Constitution that are being presented and read to the attending members at the Monthly club meetings. The Amendments, if passed by a majority vote of the Members attending the December Monthly Club meeting, will update the requirements for applicants applying for New Senior Membership with the York Rifle Range Association.

Beginning in 2016 and on, applicants applying for Senior Membership with the York Rifle Range must still be sponsored by a current Life Member or Senior Member with more than 1 year of membership with the York Rifle Range and will be reguired to obtain and submit a PATCH (Pennsylvania Access To Criminal History) report along with the completed Club application at the Pre-membership meeting.

The PATCH report will be paid for by the Applicant and can be requested online from the PA State Police website. https://epatch.state.pa.us/ or they may contact the State Police by phone to get instructions on how to get their report by mail. The Phone number for the PATCH Helpdesk is 1-888-QUERY-PA (1-888-783-7972).

The online access is faster and the report will be returned in about 2 weeks. Requesting the report by mail can take 4 to 6 weeks. An Applicant will not be put up for a vote to the membership until the PATCH report is submitted to the Membership Secretary

The applicant is responsible for paying for the PATCH report. The York Rifle Range will not refund any money for the cost of the report if the applicant is not accepted as a member for any reason.

As per the Club Constitution, An individual must be a United States Citizen or Legal Immigrant, never have been convicted of a Felony or any other Crime of Violence and is legally able to possess a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the United States.

All details of the these requirements will be sent to the applicant when they are being invited to attend a Pre-membership meeting. Failure of the applicant to obtain and submit a satisfactory PATCH report, either with their Club application or within 30 days of their attendance of the Pre-membership meeting will disqualify that applicant for membership with The York Rifle Range.

The cost of the report is \$10. To offset that cost, Applicants will only be required to pay a \$10 application fee instead of the \$20 to the Club and the \$20 yearly membership dues.

## Club elections held at the October meeting

The yearly Club elections were held at the October Monthly Club meeting. There were 17 members present that casted their vote.

All Officers are elected of a One year term and 2 of 5 Directors are up for election each year and are voted on by the members that attend the October meeting. All Senior and Life Members are eligible to cast a vote but you must be in attendance at the October meeting to do so.


## **SMALLBORE**



# **Public Site - in / Running Deer**

Mark your calendars! The annual Public Sight-in and Running Deer dates are set for the two Sundays before Thanksgiving. This year the dates are November 15 and November 22 from 8am to sunset. Don't miss it!

This event is open to the public and non-members are welcome on these dates only. Any type of hunting rifle may be sighted-in and if needed, assistance will be available.

Sight-in will be held rain or shine. Stop by the clubhouse to warm up and get some refreshments as well as conversing with fellow members and friends. There's always a good story to be heard!

80 Years 1935—2015

Weather permitting we will again hold the annual "running of the deer". Try your skills on our moving deer target. You'll get three trips across the range for a modest fee, proceeds to go to the club for range upkeep. Again this year we are continuing a 5shot string maximum for each run for safety reasons as well as reducing wear and tear on the equipment. Also for these reasons we ask that no slug guns or calibers larger than 30 cal. be fired at the deer target.

And just in case you were wondering, the pistol and shotgun ranges will also be available for use those days, too. So come on out and make a day of it!

We're sorry but the outdoor .22 range will be closed because the operators for the running deer are behind that range in the woods and they might not appreciate the gunfire coming at them from both sides of the little area they are hiding in.

The Membership Secretary will also be available those days from 11am to 4pm so you can pay your York Rifle Range 2016

**membership dues**. Payment may be made by cash or check.
