Club's Constitution, there is a grace period that extends until the **last day of January** after which, if the dues are not paid your membership becomes inactive and your access card will be deactivated and you will have to reapply when membership opens.

**Senior:** dues are \$20

**Junior:** dues are \$5

**Life Members:** dues exempt.

If you mail your payment in must be IN the Membership PO Box by **January 31, 2012**. **POSTMARKS ARE NOT USED**. So don't wait until the last week of January to mail in your dues.

The mailing address is printed on the back of your membership card along with the notice of the due date for your membership fee. I will be at the Club the two Sundays before Thanksgiving

November 13th and the 20th from 11am until 4pm to accept dues for the 2012 membership year and answer questions you may have about membership, the club or joining or renewing your **NRA Membership**. I will also accept your payment before or after the monthly club meetings in Nov. Dec. and Jan. You can also join the **NRA** or renew your current **NRA Membership**.

Also, just a reminder. Your white club access card or Key fob if you have one of those, are programmed to allow you access to the club from 6am until 11pm everyday. If you try to enter after 11:00PM and before 6:00AM your card will not open the door. Only the Club Officers, Directors, Committee members and others approved by the Officers of the club have cards that are programmed for 24 hour access.

## High Power News

The York Riflemen hosted seven matches this 2011 season (five NRA 80-round matches and two CMP John C. Garand matches). All of this season's match results can be viewed at on the club website at <http://www.yorkriflemen.org/HighPowerTeam.htm>.

The York Riflemen plans to hold our regular 2012 season matches on the 4th Sunday of the month, April through September (pending official approval). We intend to inaugurate the 2012 season with a combo-match day, tentatively scheduled for April 22, 2012. A CMP sanctioned John C. Garand Match in the morning

followed by a 50-round NRA approved High Power Match immediately after the Garand Match. Once approval is granted by the NRA and the CMP, the 2012 bulletin will be posted at link above.

The 2012 Match dates are April 22, May 27, June 24, July 22, and September 23. The Club Memorial Trophy Match will be August 26, 2012. Junior competitors are welcome, and anyone interested in the formation of a two to four-person junior team for Camp Perry is welcome to contact Fred Haag or Adam Jones.

## Frequently Asked Question

Over the last 2 years I get asked questions about the Club and Membership, here are the questions most often asked.

**Q:** I didn't receive a notice that my membership fee was due, How do I know when and where to send them in?

**A:** The club does not send out individual invoices for membership dues. Your membership fee is due EVERY year by December 31st for the following year's membership regardless of the date you joined. The grace period is now the LAST day

of JANUARY for the current membership year. The address you send them to is posted all around the Club, on the back and front page of the newsletter and on the Club's website.

**Q:** How do I get extra cards for the other members of my family?

**A:** Memberships with our club are SINGLE person memberships. We do not have "Family" memberships. If you want to get memberships for other members of your family they need to

apply for membership.

**Q:** How many people can I bring up to the club as shooting guests?

**A:** Each member is allowed only 2 guests to accompany them per visit and should be signed in at the clubhouse and the \$1.00 fee paid before you start shooting.

**Q:** Who can sponsor a person for membership?

**A:** A current Senior member with more than 1 year of membership or Life Members may sponsor a person for membership with the club.

**Q:** How long do applicants stay on the waiting list?

**A:** To make sure we have current information, an applicant is posted on the waiting list for one year from the time the pre-application is received. After one year the applicant will be removed from the list. If a person wants to continue to be on the waiting list they should contact the Membership Secretary at [yr-membership@comcast.net](mailto:yr-membership@comcast.net) leave their name and update any information that changed since they originally submitted their application. The current waiting list is posted at the clubhouse on the Membership Board and updated monthly.

## Hunting season, Public Sight-In dates set for 2011

Mark your calendars! The annual Public Sight-in and Running Deer dates are set for the two Sundays before Thanksgiving. This year the dates are **Sunday, November 13 and Sunday, November 20** from 8am to sunset. Don't miss it!

This event is open to the public and non-members are welcome on these dates. Any type of hunting rifle may be sighted-in and if needed, assistance will be available. Sight-in will be held rain or shine. Stop by the clubhouse to warm up and get some refreshments as well as conversing with fellow members and friends. There's always a good story to be heard!

Also, weather permitting we will again hold the annual "running of the deer". Try your skills on our moving deer

target. You'll get three trips across the range for a modest fee, proceeds to go to the club for range upkeep. This year we are establishing a 5-shot string maximum for each run for safety reasons as well as reducing wear and tear on the equipment. Also for these reasons we ask that no slug guns or calibers larger than 30 cal. be fired at the deer target.

The Membership Secretary will also be available those days from 11am to 4pm so you can pay your **2012 membership dues**. Payment may be made by cash or check. If you are not an NRA member, now would be a great time to join; if you are a member, you can renew thru the club. Checks are preferred for NRA membership and are to be made payable to the NRA.

As a reminder, deer hunting is permitted on club property **for members only**; no guests are permitted to hunt on club property and only antlered deer may be hunted.

And just in case you were wondering, the pistol and shotgun ranges will also still be available for use those days, too. So come on out and make a day of it!



## Attention!!

Please use common sense when using our ranges. We still have some individuals who seem to think its ok to violate our rules and destroy our facilities. Under no circumstances is anyone to shoot at or use as a target anything other than paper targets on the target ranges and clay targets on the shotgun range. This includes, but is not limited to, any structure or part of the facility, any bottles or cans (that includes plastic water bottles or anything glass, clay, or metal), bowling pins or balls, golf balls, buckets, trash cans, clothes pins, rocks, etc. Uncontrolled or sporadic firing is forbidden. Violators will risk losing their memberships! Think before you pull the trigger.

**AND one last important suggestion..... Intended for the one or few that continue to damage the club property. You've been asked a few times. STOP IT!!!!**
