## MEMBERSHIP DUES ATTENTION!!!!

At the May 13th Club meeting the Club Constitution and Rules & By Laws were updated as the last update was about 2 decades ago. Most of the updates were a couple words here and there and a little reorganization.

All of these updates and changes were announced at 3 monthly club meetings as required by the constitution. At the 3rd club meeting the updates and changes were brought up for a vote to the Club Members that attended that meeting. All of the updates can be reviewed online at the Club's Website.

**One of the MAIN CHANGES** made is the timing and date that your yearly Membership fee is due.

**Beginning immediately for the coming 2015 Membership Year, the Yearly Membership fee is DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1 each year.** There is **NO LONGER A GRACE PERIOD.**

**You may pay your membership fee for the following year anytime between October 1 and December 31. Payments not received by December 31 will result in the termination of membership.** Once a membership is terminat-

ed a person will be required to have a current Member sponsor them to reapply for membership and attend a Pre-membership meeting prior to being announced as requesting membership and being voted on.

1. This form can **ONLY** be used for **RENEWING** a Membership. If you are an active member renewing for 2015 you can use this from. **It can not be used for New Memberships.** The Waiting list form can be found at the Clubhouse.
2. If a current Junior Member is 18 on or before December 31 they will renew as a Senior Member.
3. If a current Senior Member is 65 or older on or before December 31 **AND** has been a member for 15 years or more just prior to the beginning of the year, they will transition to a Life Member as per the Club Constitution.
4. If payment is not received by December 31, your membership will be terminated and your access card deactivated.

## Public site-in dates set for 2014 / Running of the deer.

### Mark your calendars!

The dates are set for the annual Public Sight-in and Running Deer. As usual it will be the two Sundays before Thanksgiving.

This year the dates are **Sunday, November 16 and Sunday, November 23 from 8am to sunset.**

Don't miss it! This event is open to the public. Non-members are welcome on these dates. Any type of hunting rifle may be sighted-in and if needed, assistance will be available. Sight-in will be held rain or shine. Stop by the clubhouse to warm up and get some refreshments as well

as conversing with fellow members and friends.

There's always a good story to be heard!

Weather permitting, we will again hold the annual "running of the deer". Try your skills on the moving deer target. You'll get three trips across the range for a modest fee, proceeds to go to the club for range upkeep. This year we are continuing the 5-shot string maximum for each run for safety reasons as well as reducing wear and tear on the equipment. Also for these reasons we ask that no slug guns or

calibers larger than 30 cal. be fired at the deer target.

The Membership Secretary will also be available those days from 11am to 4pm so you can pay your **2015 membership dues**. Payment may be made by cash or check. If you are not currently an NRA member, now would be a great time to join; if you are a member, you can renew thru the club. Checks are preferred for NRA membership and are to be made payable to the NRA.

As a reminder, deer hunting is permitted on club

property **for members only**; no guests are permitted to hunt on club property and only antlered deer may be hunted.

And just in case you were wondering, the pistol, shotgun and indoor ranges will also still be available for use those days. So come on out and make a day of it!
