Call To Order

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for July 12, 2016 was called to order by President Doug Nace at 7:30 pm with 18 members present.

Minutes of Last Meeting

- The meeting minutes for June 14, 2016 was read by Recording Secretary, Jeff Walters. Dick Ide made a motion to approve with no corrections, and this was seconded by Bob Mitzel. Motion was approved by membership.

Membership Secretary's Report

Small Bore Report

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- We had two outdoor matches since the last meeting. South team lost one match and one the other match.
- South team is two points ahead of the north team in the ICRL outdoor season.
- Next outdoor match will be on July 22nd at Seitzland.
- Smallbore nationals is going on now at Bristol, IN

Big Bore Report

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- We had 23 shooters at the June highpower match. Clay Miller was overall match winner.
- We are seeing more scoped service rifles on the line. So far there has not been an improvement in scores with the scoped rifles. The scope technology needs to get up to speed for the demands of highpower service rifle competition. The jury is still out.
- Next match will be on July 24th. Dick Ide will be running it with the help of Joe Kling.

- Some of our regular highpower shooters will be leaving for Camp Perry on Friday & Saturday, July 22 & 23rd. The club has reserved 3 huts for the duration of the highpower segment of the National Matches.

Junior Program

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Junior air program is still running smoothly. Summertime attendance has been lower than during the school year. We did have two new shooters show up at the last open shooting session. They show a lot of promise
- We went ahead and got the process rolling with the CMP to order the four new Anschutz target rifles. Did get notified that the rifles have been shipped and should be available to pick up at the end of week. That is the good news. The bad news is that the left hand CMP version was not available and was replaced with a standard Anschutz 1903 w/o sights. The bill was \$155 lower than the check sent to Creedmoor Sports. A refund check will be sent to the club for the difference. Jeff Walters has an extra set of sights that he will donate to complete the rifle.

Building and Grounds

- Nothing really new.
- We did get prices for the replacement of the range and refrigerator. Will discuss at the board meeting after the general membership meeting.
- New shed has been added to the end of the main building, and the new swipe card lock has been installed for the indoor smallbore range & back room.
- Indoor range remodel will be started shortly once there has been some finalization with the Board of Directors.
- Access to the indoor range is still open to all members. Once a certification class has been developed and being offered on a regular basis the access to the indoor range will be only granted to those members that have completed the certification class. This should start in a few weeks.

Legislative

- Due the election cycle, and the current violence nationwide, 2nd amendment issues are at the forefront. Vote your conscience and keep contacting your elected officials of the support of the 2nd amendment.
- Assistant DA of York County, Dave Sunday, contacted Doug Nace. He is already preparing for the campaign two years from now. We may try to get him to come in and give a talk prior to the election.
