



## **York Rifle Range Association, Inc. Meeting Minutes for 1/10/2017**

### **Call To Order**

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for 1/10/2017 was called to order by Vice President Dick Ide at 7:30 pm with 17 members present.

- Our books have been audited for 2016. They were given a clean bill of health by the auditor.
- Our newly elected treasurer was introduced during the meeting. Cheryl Gerhardt will be taking over the treasurer role with Ken Kreiger retiring from the position.

### **Membership Secretary's Report**

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1060 Senior: 59 Junior: 316 Life: 3 Active Military: 1438 Total Membership.
- Current Wait list: 140 Senior: 3 Junior.
- 112 senior and 3 junior members did not renew for 2017.
- A total of 130 senior memberships will be available for 2017.
- Pre-membership will begin prior to the February meeting for those on the membership waitlist.
- 290 members have gone through the indoor range qualification class, and have been cleared to use the indoor range.

### **Small Bore Report**

- Greg Livingston gave the report. We have had three more indoor matches since the last meeting. We did not gain and more points, and we are currently in last place.
- Next match will be this coming Friday at home.

### **Big Bore Report**

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- We have submitted the dates for our highpower matches to the NRA for approval. Matches will be held on the 4th Sunday of each month, April- September, The only exception will be the July match which will be held on the 5th Sunday so as to not be in conflict with the National Matches.
- We will have two CMP matches on April 23rd and October 7th.
- There will be no highpower clinic this year. We only had one attendee of the clinic come out and shoot a highpower match at a later date. We will reassess next year to see if there is a need to hold another clinic.
- Fred will address the BOD about a club purchase of bulk bullets for the team.

- Still running smoothly. Over the holidays attendance did drop. Attendance has ticked back up to about 15 shooters each week.
- We are still in a holding pattern with the NRA grant. Waiting to hear back from them. Should be soon though.

### **Legislative**

- With the change in administration in Washington D.C., there has been a few pro gun bills introduced in congress. The main highlights are a bill to make sound suppressor legal without the ATF paperwork, and a bill to institute concealed carry reciprocity between all states in the country.

- Greg Livingston officially installed the directors and officers of the club for the 2017 calendar year. All directors and officers, with the exception of the President Doug Nace, were installed. President Doug Nace will be installed at the next meeting in February.
- We had further discussion on the process of the opt-in to use the indoor range for the new prospective members. Consensus with the members was to have the new members sign up just like all previous members and have it at a different time other than the pre membership meeting.
- The officers and directors had approved at the last directors meeting to allow Mitzi Eaton to release rehabbed birds of prey on the club property.
