## **Junior Program**

- Vice President Ide read a report prepared by Jeff Walters
- Junior air rifle will begin on 9/25 and continue through the end of May. We will be using the indoor range Monday evenings between 6:30-9:00 PM
- Friends of the NRA 2018 grant requests have been completed and were submitted on 8/10. We are now in a waiting mode until winter to see if we will get any continued funding. We submitted two separate grant requests, one for air rifle and one for the club junior programs as a whole.
- The juniors participating in the smallbore team have transitioned to indoor 3p practice for the upcoming indoor league matches.
- We did receive a nice email thanking the club and its volunteers for providing a junior marksmanship program.

## **Building and Grounds**

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Tyler Glock Eagle Scout project is now complete. The moisture seal paint on the chimney will be allowed to cure for a few months before we will paint it red in 2018.
- Due to the poor shooting abilities the steel pistol target frames are constantly getting peppered with errant shots, and are constantly being repainted. The hanging steel plates on the pistol range are in a poor shape because of members using FMJ bullets. The steel targets are only to be shot with lead bullets.
- There will be at least two work days this fall. The 10/7 work day will revolve around patching the driveway potholes removal of a tree that fell on to a neighbors property, and finish wrapping the pistol enclosure. The 11/11 workday will be prep work for the running deer open house on 11/12 and 11/19
- Fireplace door has been removed to reseal and cure the gasket. Will place it back on the fireplace when the gasket has cured.
- Chimney sign was taken down for the painting project. Will need to be refurbished and painted over the winter to place it back on the chimney exterior in 2018.
- Looking at three more minor projects for 2017. Replace the roof on the pistol range and running deer enclosure, and new door for the block house.
- We got a small ramp from the York-Adams club to aid in the accessibility of our less mobile members and guests. It has been placed outside our front door.

- Legislature is looking at tougher Protection from abuse enforcements, and regulations regarding guns in schools.
