### **Meeting Minutes for February 13, 2018**

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for February 13, 2018 was called to order by President Doug Nace at 7:30 pm with 23 members present.

### **Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.**

### **Minutes of previous meeting.**

- The Minutes of the January 9, 2018 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- No Changes were needed and a motion was made by Rick Ide, and seconded by George Himmelright. A vote was taken and the minutes were approved by membership present.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhardt.
- Please see Treasurer's report attached to the meeting minutes located in the clubhouse lobby.
- The club accounts were audited on February 3rd, and everything was found to be order and no problems were noted.

### **Membership Report**

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1124 Senior, 53 Junior, 331 Life, 3 Active Military, 1511 Total.
- Wait list is currently at 84 senior, 5 junior. With more names to add to the list for next month's report.
- New membership drive to fill the vacant spots will begin at the April meeting. We will accept approx 30 per meeting so that the clubhouse and parking lot does not get over crowded.
- Patch Report now costs \$22 instead of \$8. Club application is still \$10 and annual senior dues is still \$20. Email invites will go out to the first group of applicants early March.

### **Smallbore Report**

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- Four matches since the last meeting. We are still in 4th place and the next match will be away at North End this Friday.

### **Big Bore Report**

- Nothing to report except we did get our club affiliation packet back from the CMP.

### **Junior Program Report**

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Still going well. Still averaging 10-15 shooters each week.

- One of our Junior shooters, Trinity Bogdany, will be participating in a smallbore 3p regional match at Ontelaunee Gun Club this coming Sunday. Coach Jeff, Trinity and her dad will go up Sunday morning. She is young enough to be in the sub junior category and she has been shooting well in the league matches so she will probably do well at this match.
- Nothing official yet but we did get notified by Kay Hughes that the regional NRA Foundation approved our two grants for the sum of around \$7500. Still needs to be forwarded to the National level, but everything is still on track. Should know in a few weeks of the final outcome. Most of the grant proceeds will go towards replacing our current fleet of air rifles with newer PCP sporter class air rifles.
- Friends of the NRA banquet will be held on March 2nd and we have at least 10 members signed up to go.
- Implemented a lead abatement program in conjunction with the air rifle and indoor smallbore programs. All juniors are required to use special Lead off soap after each practice session in the indoor range. Also, Jeff Walters will come up and do a thorough sweeping and mopping of the indoor range to remove as much particulate material from floor and other surfaces every two weeks or as needed.

### **Building and Grounds Report**

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Thank you to Mike Devilla for cleaning, prepping, and painting the clubhouse wall by the fireplace.
- Coal bin is empty of firewood. When the ground dries out will retrieve some fire wood that is stacked elsewhere on the club grounds to replenish the coal bin.
- The subject of adding more lighting at the lower parking lot will be brought up at the next director' meeting.
- Two bids have been submitted to do the electrical work by the running deer shelter. Will discuss at the directors meeting.
- We currently have a problem with our gate. We will contact a repair service to fix.
- Heating oil tank is getting low and will need to be filled.
- Septic tank also needs to be pumped out.

### **Legislative Report**

- NRA Board of Directors election is currently up for a vote. NRA voting members are members who have five years or more continuous membership or life members. Suggest voting for Maria Heil from New Freedom and she is a current NRA Director. She has helped our club in the past and is a good person to promote and support the 2nd amendment causes.
- A gun rights rally will be held at the Capitol rotunda in Harrisburg on April 30th @10 AM. Info for the rally is located on the table in the clubhouse.
- Petitions for people who want to be on the Primary ballot are out now.
