York Rifle Range Association, Inc. Meeting Minutes for June 12, 2018

Call To Order

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for June 12, 2018 was called to order by President Doug Nace at 7:30 pm with 26 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group

Minutes of Last Meeting

- Recording Secretary, Jeff Walters, read the meeting minutes for the May 8, 2018 general membership meeting. There were no changes or corrections needed and a motion as made by Greg Livingston and seconded by Norm Taylor to approve the minutes as read. A vote was taken and the motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report

- George Himmelright gave the report prepared by Treasurer Cheryl Gerhardt.

- All club accounts will be audited at the end of the year.
- John Stare had a question as to the location of the Treasurer's report in the club house. The location was pointed out to John and the other members present. The location is on the bulletin board to the right of the doors to the indoor range. The current treasurer's report is attached to the back of the monthly meeting minutes. It was noted that years ago it was included in the online version of the meeting minutes, but due to the sensitive and public nature of the club's website this practice was stopped and a hard copy is made available to club members in the clubhouse lobby.

Membership Secretary's Report

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- The last batch of prospective new members were presented during the meeting. A total of 21 senior and 1 junior were announced for a final vote to be taken during the July meeting.
- Prospective new members that were presented during the May meeting were again announced during the meeting. A motion was made by Fred Haag and seconded by Greg Livingston to approve the new members. A vote was taken and the 24 senior and 1 junior new members were approved unanimously.

- Two indoor range Certification classes have been scheduled in June 18th and July 15th. Those members with email addresses on file have been notified.

Small Bore Report

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- South team is leading by one point after the addition of 2 night matches and one day match.
- We have 4 juniors from our club shooting in the outdoor league, and they are doing well.
- Next match will be this coming Friday at home.
- League banquet was hosted by Columbia F&G. It was well attended with 50-70 people. Morgan Fisher earned an award for Junior high outdoor aggregate, and Trinity Bogdany gained in NRA qualification levels since last year.

Big Bore Report

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- The May 27th match was held over Memorial Day weekend and was won by Frank Wasco with a 779-24x score. High Service rifle was shot by Jeremy Bogdany with a score of 774-24x.
- Next match is June 24th.
- Group of York members will be heading out to Perry in July. Currently in being housed in barracks but waiting for upgrade to Huts if they come available.

Junior Program

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Monday night air rifle sessions will be shut down for the summer. Will start back up in Early September.
- We finally received our NRA grant PCP sporter class air rifles. We received seven from the NRA and Coach Jeff Walters purchased and donated an eighth rifle to fill our firing points. One air rifle has a slight issue and I will need to contact warranty repair to get it fixed.
- Our Junior smallbore shooters are doing well. Three of our more experienced shooters have signed up to attend the prone school at Seitzland and will shoot at the 3200 match the following weekend.
- A few months ago the Officers and directors approved to donation of our CO2 powered air rifles along with support equipment since we were receiving a new compliment from the NRA Grant. Our stock of CO2 rifles will be divided between the York County 4H and the York Adams Rifle & Pistol club. They will have new homes in the next week or two.

Building and Grounds

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- He thanked all those members who helped out while George was incapacitated last month.
- There is an additional 300 holes in the 50 yd target frames. The frames are only a few months old.
- There is a bid for the addition of the Honorable Jim Jensen Parking light. Will discuss at the directors meeting.

- Primary election was held and the General in November.
- Maria Heil was reelected tot he NRA Board of Directors.

- Pending insurance for the new tractor and it has been taken care of.
