Meeting Minutes for September 11, 2018

Minutes of previous meeting.

- Two NRA Foundation grants were submitted for 2019. One for air rifle and one for general youth programs. Individual grant proposals are a little smaller this year due to the fact we have just about enough to keep us going. Will be in a holding pattern until late winter to see what we have been awarded.
- We are having Wednesday night practice for the youth smallbore shooters to prepare for the indoor season. Besides the basic fundamentals we are irking a little more on sports psychology, and in time should have a deep field to represent the York team.

Building and Grounds Report

New Business

Good or Welfare of the Club

- Jeff Walters wanted to clarify that paper targets are the only approved targets on the high power rifle range. He noticed numerous clay pigeons scattered throughout the 50 & 100yd backstops. While not a major issue it needs to be addressed if a member is caught using prohibited targets.
- Rick Ide suggested that the next batch of 50 yd targets be the bull design instead of the 6 bull design. This might reduce the damage to the wood target supports.

- A motion was made by Devin Pence and seconded by Greg Livingston to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved and the meeting was adjourned at 8:12 PM.
