### **Meeting Minutes for October 9, 2018**

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for October 9, 2018 was called to order by Doug Nace at 7:30 pm with 30 members present.

### **Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.**

### **Minutes of previous meeting.**

- The Minutes of the September 11, 2018 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- No corrections were needed and a motion was made by Fred Haag and seconded by George Himmelright to approve the minutes as read. The vote was taken and it was approved unanimously.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- The monthly Treasurer's report was submitted by Treasurer Cheryl Gerhart and read by George Himmelright.

### **Membership Report**

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1196 Senior, 60 Junior, 329 Life, 3 Active Military, 1588 Total
- Currently there are 39 on the waitlist.
- 7 junior and 64 seniors have paid for 2019 membership. Jim has started to collect for 2019 on October 1st.

### **Smallbore Report**

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- We have shot two indoor matches so far. The first match was away at Palmyra and a home match against North End. We earned one point during the match with North End. Next match will be away at Seitzland
- South team did win the outdoor season again. This is three years in a row.

### **Big Bore Report**

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- To close out the 2018 highpower season we hosted a CMP Garand match. We had 20 individual shooters and had a reentry match with 8 shooters. For a total of 28 shooters. Matt Zagorski won the match shooting his K31 and shooting a score of 288-7x. we had a good draw of shooters coming from Virginia, Southern Maryland, and New Jersey.

## **Junior Program Report**

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- We started air rifle back up on October 1st. Attendance has been light so far with no new shooters and just kids returning from last season.
- Expect an uptick in attendance once the clubs newsletter goes out.
- Still in a holding pattern for the 2019 NRA Foundation grants.
- High pressure air pump is still on backorder. We will make do with the hand pump and reserve air tank for the time being.
- The new air rifles are working well, and we have gotten a lot of compliments from the kids shooting them.

## **Building and Grounds Report**

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Thank you to the 10 members that assisted in the driveway work on our first work day this fall.
- We used a total of 1600 lbs of cold patch to fill most of the pot holes. Three potholes still need to be filled and we will take care of them during the next work day. The Kubota lawn tractor was also serviced during the work day.
- Next work day will be on 11/3. Planned for this day is the remaining potholes and cut, split, and stack firewood. If enough people show up do more cleanup in the garage and club house.
- We will also have an additional work day on 11/10 to set up for the running deer/open house.
- A member has stepped forward to help maintain the club's clay pigeon throwers.
- Ford Tractor is still for sale.
- Water pipes still need to be upgraded in the well pit.
- Leaves need to be blowed in a few weeks.
- As a reminder if you do not how to use and properly adjust the fireplace do not use it. Ask an officer or one of the regulars to assist if needed, so that damage will not occur.
