Meeting Minutes for December 11, 2018

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for December 11, 2018 was called to order by Doug Nace at 7:31 pm with 23 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the November 13, 2018 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- A motion was made by Devin Pence and seconded by George Himmelright to approve the minutes as read. A vote was taken and the motion as approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- The monthly Treasurer's report was submitted by Cheryl Gerhart and read into record by George Himmelright.

Membership Report

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1196 Senior, 60 Junior, 328 Life, 3 Active Military, 1587 Total
- So far there have been 780 senior and 38 junior memberships renewed for 2019. We have also received multiple donations from life and other members during the 2019 membership renewal period.
- Current wait list is 61 senior and 4 juniors.

Smallbore Report

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- Due to Thanksgiving and deer season we have had only two smallbore matches since the last meeting, one Bye at home and an away match at Columbia. We took 4 points during the Columbia match.
- Next match will be a postal match shot at home against North End. We will then break for the holidays and have another Bye match on 1/4.

Big Bore Report

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- Nothing new, just getting ready for the start of the 2019 season in the spring.

Junior Program Report

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Air Rifle is still going well with around 10 shooters each week. And we have added around 4 new juniors this season.
- Trinity Bogdany is doing well and shot an excellent match at Columbia with her best score yet, tying J. Walters in total agg score, and beating him in prone and standing positions. Coach, Teammates, and Family are proud of her excellent shooting.
- High pressure air pump is still on back order, and NRA Foundation grant is still pending approval.
- Looking at taking a few junior shooters to Camp Perry in 2019. CMP will be hosting a 6400 prone match and a team prone match in mid-July.

Building and Grounds Report

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Well pit still needs plumbing upgrades.
- Running Deer electrical project has been half paid for and is pending completion. This was approved by the directors at their last meeting. This will add a new breaker box and be a jumping off point to eventually add electric service to the highpower pit area.
- We will need to get a new rope for the running deer before next fall.
- One of the dimmable LED light fixtures has stopped working in the indoor range and will need to be looked at to be repaired or replaced.

Legislative Report

- House bill HR 7115 has been submitted in congress. This poorly written bill is aimed at outlawing the ownership of 80% frames and receivers. It will also outlaw the practice of using firearm kits to manufacture home built guns. Due to the poorly written proposed legislation it can be construed that the any part that makes a gun functional will also be forbidden from private purchase. Things like barrels, trigger mechanisms, bolts, firing pins, etc can only be procured from a licensed gunsmith or ffl .
- Although our state and federal representatives are solidly pro gun it is important to keep in contact to voice your opinion on gun legislation matters. Phone calls, emails and letters are vital to get our opinion heard.

Old Business

- The Board of Directors approved and granted permission for our neighbor to use the lower portion of our driveway to gain access his wooded lot for tree removal.
- At the last membership meeting a suggestion was made to make the firing lines non smoking. After some discussion the Board of Directors approved the placement of signage to ask that smokers be courteous to other shooters under the shooting pavillions.
- Still waiting to hear back from the local forester to get an estimate on removing some of our older growth trees located west of the clubhouse for sale and using the funds to support projects around the club grounds.
