Meeting Minutes for March 12, 2019

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for March 12, 2019 was called to order by Doug Nace at 7:30 pm with 16 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the February 12, 2019 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- There were no corrections or changes needed and a motion was made, seconded, and approved by the members present.

Treasurer's Report

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhart.

- Copies of our general ledger was mailed to our outside auditor for review.

Membership Report

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1108 Senior, 48 Junior, 348 Life, 3 Active Military, 1507 Total
- Currently senior wait list is down to 51 senior and 3 juniors.
- Invitations were sent out to 30 senior and 4 junior on the waitlist. They will be at the April pre-membership meeting. So far 13 people have responded.
- Newsletter should be going out in the mail this coming week. Email copy of the newsletter went out to those members with a good email address. There 817 good email addresses are on file and has helped save on printing and mailing costs.

Smallbore Report

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- We had three matches since the last meeting. No points were earned.
- Indoor 3p season is winding down and will be finished in two weeks.
- Outdoor season will start on April 26th.
- Annual league meeting will be this Sunday @ Columbia, 2pm. Youth scholarship applications will be reviewed at that time.
- We will finish in 4th place this year for the indoor season.

Big Bore Report

- Fred Haag gave the report.

- First match will be on April 28th with a Garand match in the morning followed by a 50 shot highpower match in the afternoon.
- All highpower matches fired at York Riflemen will be fired under CMP rules and oversight. There is not a real difference between NRA and CMP rules. The only minor difference is the CMP rules do not allow for a shooter alibi.

Junior Program Report

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Things are about the same 8-10 shooters each week. Last night was a little light with two shooters so we had the parents join the youth shooters on the line to shoot some offhand practice.
- Still no official word from the NRA on our grant status. York county did have its NRA Foundation banquet on 3/1 and it was announced we were getting approx \$6500 in equipment, supplies, and smallbore ammunition.

Building and Grounds Report

- Planning on having two work days this spring. April 20th and May 18th. Will be in the morning 8:30 to around noon. Jobs include typical cutting, splitting, and stacking of fire wood, repair of the bullet hole in the highpower roof, pothole patching in the driveway.

- It appears that the wood removal on the neighboring property is complete.
