- Makeup Garand and 500 agg highpower match on September 13th. Tom Lowry won the 500agg and Eric Updike won the Garand match with an unlimited modern military rifle and Sean Leighton was top Garand shooter.
- Last Garand match had a good turnout with 24 entries. Jeff Kauffman won with modern military rifle and Colin Cash was top vintage shooter with a 1903 Springfield.
