Meeting Minutes for July 13,2021

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for July 13, 2021 was called to order by President Ide at 7:55 pm with 20 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the June 8, 2021 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters. No corrections were needed and a motion was made by Greg Livingston and seconded by George Himmelright to approve the minutes as read. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhart.
- Please see Treasurer's report attached to the meeting minutes located in the clubhouse lobby.
- All club accounts will be audited at the end of the year.
- Like every other property owner in the county our school taxes are due in August. Will need to transfer about \$4000 to cover the annual expense.
- Would like to look into a different heating oil supplier to see if we can save some money.

Membership Report

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- We had new group of 22 prospective members in this evening. Their names will be posted in the clubhouse and will be voted on during the August meeting.
- The prospective members introduced during the June meeting were voted on tonight. A motion was made by Doug Nace and seconded by Greg Livingston to approve the 19 senior and 6 junior prospective members. After a brief discussion the motion was approved by members present.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1150 Senior, 43 Junior, 382 Life, 6 Active Military, 1581 Total
- Currently there are 27 open senior memberships available.
- Current wait list is 76 senior and 3 juniors.
- Looking at options to having new member orientation on a different day besides a regular Tuesday night meeting night. Will discuss further with the club leaders involved.

Smallbore Report

- Greg Livingston gave the report.
- One league match was shot since the last meeting and team white won. Next match will be this Friday here at York.
- A small contingent of York members will be going to Camp Perry this year. Jeff Walters will be there for the entire 6400 match along with the team and sudden death playoff match. Junior Jacob Sands will attend the Iron Sight stage and Greg Livingston will attend the Any Sight stage.

Big Bore Report

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- Ian Swisher shot an excellent service rifle score of 785 in the last match here at York.
- About 10 York shooters will be going up to Camp Perry to the shoot the Highpower Stage.
- Next match will be July 25th.

Junior Program Report

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Going smoothly. Juniors have been attending practice and matches.
- Air rifle will start back up in October.
- Our 2021 NRA Foundation grant was approved. Will be getting two cases of CCI Std Velocity ammunition, one case of SK target ammo, five bricks of Eley Match ammo, and a check for \$835 earmarked for the purchase of additional ammunition. Already in the process of scrounging for additional ammo. Total amount might go over the \$835 grant but will not exceed an additional \$400 outlay by the club.

Building and Grounds Report

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Brush clean up along the driveway has been going smoothly.
- Continuing to solicit bids to replace the clubhouse windows.
- Start looking at what we need to pave and what remains gravel. Current costs of paving and materials may have us postpone the project.
- To make Jeff Walters' life a little easier a quick hitch for the Mahindra was purchased and donated to the club. This makes attaching the brush hog a much simpler and less time consuming endeavor.

Legislative Report

- The Biden Administration is still pushing a strong anti-gun agenda.
- Confirmation of David Chipman as head of ATF is still held up in the senate. Call your senators and demand a no vote for Chipman.
- We are still in the comment period for the proposed ATF regulation changes. Involving what defines a firearm, etc.

New Business

- Two people on the current wait list are York highpower shooting members and will be attending the national matches. Is it possible to allow a provisional shooting team member card to these two members while attending the matches. No one saw a problem with this and will be allowed as was done in past years.
- Some Smallbore shooters would like to place a semi permanent sun cover located near firing points 1-6. Cost would be around \$129 and would consist of a 10x20 car port cover. This would be a test to see if this could eventually be extended along the firing line for use during practices and matches. If the testing is satisfactory this would be a low cost option to covering the firing line. If unsuccessful we would need to look at other options in the future.
