### **Meeting Minutes for November 9, 2021**

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for November 9, 2021 was called to order by President Ide at 7:30 pm with 14 members present.

### **Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.**

### **Minutes of previous meeting.**

- The Minutes of the October 12, 2021 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- One correction was needed and a motion was made by Doug Nace and seconded by Frank Herring to approve the corrected minutes. This was approved unanimously.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhart.

- All club accounts will be audited at the end of the year.

### **Membership Report**

- Membership Secretary, Jim Jensen gave the report.
- Membership totals are as follows: 1195 Senior, 44 Junior, 379 Life, 6 Active Military, 1624 Total
- Current waitlist is 59 senior and 2 junior.
- So far 308 senior and 13 juniors have renewed for 2022.
- Currently there are 572 club members that are also NRA members this accounts for 35% of our membership.
- Indoor range cert class will be held on the running deer days. Three students one the first day and two on the second day.

### **Smallbore Report**

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Currently in the middle of our indoor season. Next match will be home against Palmyra.
- One of our junior shooters, Trinity Bogdany, shot her best aggregate score in a 3p match with an impressive 575 out of a possible 600 points.
- We may have another junior shooter join us in the Smallbore league matches.

### **Big Bore Report**

- Fred Haag gave the report.
- Highpower season is over. Will start back up in the spring with a similar schedule compared to previous years.
- Getting the running deer equipment prepped for the upcoming sight in days held here at the club.

### **Junior Program Report**

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Still going well. We have around 4-5 juniors each week.
- We will run the air rifle program through the end of March.

### **Building and Grounds Report**

- George Himmelright gave the report.
- Very good turnout for our fall work detail held on October 30th. Had around 40 members show up to lend a hand on various projects.
- Garage has been cleaned out.
- Wood pile has been split and stacked in bins.
- Ron will eventually take care of clearing and pushing back the debris along the rifle range.
- Steel targets are holding up well on the rifle range.
- Brett placed some cold patch in front of the pistol range firing point to direct water runoff away from the covered firing point.
- Devin Pentz repaired the ridge vent on the clubhouse roof. It was not installed properly and was causing water leaks. Overall the roof is in decent shape but will need to be replaced in around 5+ years.

### **Legislative Report**

- There is some pro gun legislation moving through the state legislature. Will most likely pass but is subject to a governor veto.
- A lot of candidates are throwing their hat in to the open governor and senate seats for the 2022 election.
- U.S. Supreme Court listened to oral arguments for the NY concealed carry law. Judgement will be released in a few months.

### **Old Business**

- Membership to the NRA junior division is due. In the past we paid for a three year term. Need to correct the address with the NRA.

### **New Business**

- Running deer is coming up and we are planning on having food like in years past.

### **Good or Welfare of the Club**

- Sad news to report, Kay Hughes passed away suddenly. She was the membership secretary at Seitzland and an important volunteer for the the NRA Foundation. She was instrumental in supporting local junior programs in York County.
- Someone set up a hunting tree stand in the impact area of the shotgun range. It was decided to take the stand down and place at the base of the tree with a note directing them to place the tree stand about 50 yds to the east to avoid getting injured from shotgun pellets if someone is using the shotgun range.
