Meeting Minutes for April 12, 2022

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for April 12, 2022 was called to order by President Ide at 7:38 pm with 18 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the March 8, 2022 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters. No corrections were needed and a motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes as read. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhart.
- Annual audit was completed. Report has not been submitted yet but there were no problems observed.

Membership Report

- The first batch of prospective new members were introduced this evening. Thirty three senior and two junior prospective members will be up for final vote during the May meeting. Seven of the prospective members did not bring their PATCH report as required in the instructions. This was the largest amount on non compliance yet. Jim will give them till this weekend to submit their PATCH report. Otherwise they will be pulled from membership.

Smallbore Report

- Currently on hiatus between the indoor and outdoor seasons. First outdoor match will be a day match at Seitzland on April 23rd.

Junior Program Report

- Jeff Walters gave the report.
- Monday night air rifle wrapped up at the end of March. Will start back up in early October.
- One of our juniors is slated to go to CMP Smallbore National matches in July.
- NRA foundation grant has been approved. We are getting two cases (10k rounds) of CCI Std Vel, two cases (10k rounds) of SK std plus, six bricks (3k rounds) Lapua center X, 1k USA50 Smallbore targets, 1k 10m air rifle targets, 5k air rifle pellets, hand stops, spotting scope and stand. All in all around \$4500 worth of supplies and equipment.

Building and Grounds Report

- Septic holding tanks needed to be pumped.
- Work detail is scheduled for April 16th. Items to be addressed if we have people show up. Running deer roof replacement, repair of electrical service at the running deer shed, fill wood bins, painting of porch posts, painting on indoor range, general range repairs (50yd target frames), leaf removal in the target pit, removal of old coal bin, roll the range.

- Doug Nace has been interviewing candidates for senate and governor particularly in regards to firearms. Getting good feedback from those interviewed.

- ATF released their finalized rules regarding the redefinition of frames/ receivers, silencers, 80% kits, FFL dealers must hold onto 4473's indefinitely, instead of the 20 year rule.
