Meeting Minutes for May 10, 2022

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for May 10, 2022 was called to order by President Ide at 7:35 pm with 19 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the April 12, 2022 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- No corrections were needed and a motion was made to approve the minutes as rear. This was seconded and approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- The monthly Treasurer's report was read and submitted by Cheryl Gerhart.

- Thirty three prospective senior and two prospective junior members that attended the orientation meeting last month were up for consideration tonight. Discussion ensued and a member had a concern as to the quality of the prospective new members since many of them did not follow the directions. Due to this concern he will make a symbolic nay vote. After the discussion concluded a motion was made and seconded to approve the new members. Vote results were in the affirmative with one nay vote and one abstention.
