Meeting Minutes for July 12, 2022

- The York Rifle Range Association meeting for July 12, 2022 was called to order by President Ide at 7:30 pm with 15 members present.

Pledge of allegiance was recited by the group.

Minutes of previous meeting.

- The Minutes of the June 14, 2022 meeting were read by Secretary Jeff Walters.
- No corrections were needed and a motion was made by George Himmelright and Jim Arvin to approve the minutes as read. Motion was approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

Membership Report

- We had twenty two people attend last month's pre membership meeting. One did not turn in a patch report. The remaining twenty one people were presented for a membership vote this evening. After a brief discussion a motion was made by George Himmelright and seconded by Greg Livingston to approve the new members. This motion was passed by the current members present at the meeting.
- We had eight people attend tonight's orientation meeting, their names will be posted in the clubhouse and they will be voted on during the August membership meeting.
