CMP Sanctioned Matches (Non-EIC and John C Garand)



DATES: April 28 * (50 shot Nat'l Match Course) fired after the April Garand Springfield Vintage Mod Military match 800 AGG CMP non-EIC High Power Matches will be fired as CMP Cup Match Event with sighters - May 26; June 23; August 25 (Memorial Trophy Match); and September 22, 2024

All matches except the April 28 match will be 80 shot Regional Match Course CMP Approved matches unless changed by Match Director *(Sign-up for April 28 CMP Match at 12 noon)

PLACE: York Riflemen, Hellam Township, York County, PA www.yorkriflemen.org

DIRECTIONS: From South of York: Take I-83 N to Rt. 30 East to Mt. Zion Rd. (north)

From Reading, PA area: Take Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West to Mt. Zion Rd. (north)

From Philadelphia area: Take PA Turnpike (I-76 W) to I-83 S (exit 18) to Rt. 30 East to Mt. Zion Rd.

(north)

Then: Take Mt. Zion Road (north) past Galleria Mall; Turn right onto Druck Valley Road; Turn left onto

Range Road; entrance to York Riflemen is located at the top of the hill on the right.

TIME: Registration from **7:30** am to **7:55** am on the day of the match; relay assignments are on a first-come/ first-

serve basis (no advance sign-up) and limited to the first 40 shooters or four relays; first relay starts at 8:00; squadding for pit and scoring services will be done at registration (Sign-up for April 24 High Power Match

at 12)

MATCH FEE: All Match fees matches \$15.00 / \$10.00 juniors please - no checks.

Fee for August 28- (80 shot RMC) YR Memorial Trophy Match - \$20.00 / \$15.00 juniors (rain date is

September match).

COMPETITION: Open to all shooters; beginners are welcome - instruction is available.

CLASSIFICATION: CMP classification will be used; for award presentations, a class will be made up of no less than 5 shooters.

RULES: Current CMP High Power Rifle rules will apply. Challenges \$1.00

Matches will be conducted as CMP Cup Match event with sighters and starting rapid-fire series in

position. Competitors will be required to pull targets OR OTHER DUTIES AS ASSIGNED

COURSE OF FIRE: 80 shot Regional Match Course (reduced) - 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes prior to each stage and:

Stage #1: 20 rounds Slow Fire Standing; 200 yards; 20 minutes; SR

Stage #2: 2 strings - 10 rounds Rapid Fire Sitting; 200 yards; 60 sec/string; SR Stage #3: 2 strings - 10 rounds Rapid Fire Prone; 200 yards; 70 sec/string; SR-42

Stage #4: 20 rounds Slow Fire Prone; 200 yards; 20 minutes; MR-52

GENERAL INFO:

. All shooters should possess a spotting scope or binoculars to be used for scoring purposes.

2. Club M1 Garand rifles will be available for use by all shooters; ammo will be provided @ \$20.00 .All ammo distributed MUST be fired at the match.

3. AR-15 club rifles are available; .223 ammo is available @ \$20.00 for club AR15s.

4. POSITIVELY NO HANDLOADS WILL BE USED IN ANY CLUB RIFLES; only factory loaded, non-corrosive ammo will be allowed in club rifles (chief range officer reserves the right to inspect and approve/disapprove all ammo used for the match).

5. No tracer or incendiary ammunition permitted.

6. Limited refreshments and restroom facilities are available.

7. Courses of fire may be altered at Match director's discretion.

<u>John C Garand, Springfield, Modern Military & Vintage Match – April 28 and October 5, 2024</u>

The John C. Garand Match is the CMP's most popular CMP Games event held during the National Matches. The course of fire is the CMP John C. Garand A -30 rounds (200 yards) 15 shots slow-fire prone (first 5 shots are sighters); 10 shots rapid-fire prone; 10 shots slow fire standing. All shot from 200 yards.

Location and Directions to Range:

From South of York: Take I-83 N to Rt. 30 East to Mt. Zion Rd. (north)

From Reading, PA area: Take Rt. 222 South to Rt. 30 West to Mt. Zion Rd. (north)

From Philadelphia area: Take PA Turnpike (I-76 W) to I-83 S (exit 18) to Rt. 30 East to Mt. Zion Rd. (north) *Then*: Take Mt. Zion Road (north) past Galleria Mall; Turn <u>right</u> onto Druck Valley Road; Turn

<u>left</u> onto Range Road; entrance to York Riflemen is located at the top of the hill on the <u>right</u>.

Open to: US citizens eligible per CMP rules. Shooters under 18 must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.

Participants must obtain and retain on file a notarized *Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement*. These forms are available at the CMP website at http://thecmp.org/competitions/forms/ (*not necessary if you already have an affidavit on file with the CMP)

Entry fee: \$20 (M2 Ball Ammunition is available for purchase @ \$20 for 40 rounds)

Registration: 7:30 a.m., Match begins at 8:30 a.m. First shot 30 minutes after registration. Be on time.

Course of Fire: CMP John C. Garand A -30 rounds, 200 yards

Governing Rules: Civilian Marksmanship Program Competition Rules

Awards: CMP Achievement Pins for each Garand, Springfield, and Vintage (not for service rifle.)

General Information: Hearing and eye protection is mandatory.

M2 Ball will be issued to competitors firing Garand and Springfield rifles

A Shooting mat or 2' by 6' piece of carpeting is recommended.

Bring water/drinks, lunch, etc.
